## **NEW Quadrivalent Flu Vaccine:**

- Protects against 2 influenza A and 2 influenza B
- Approved for ages 4 years and older



## **Intradermal Quadrivalent Flu Vaccine:**

- Protects against 2 influenza A and
  2 influenza B
- Approved for ages 18 through 64 years of age

## **High-dose Flu Vaccine (trivalent):**

- Protects against 2 influenza A and 1 influenza B
- Recommended for ages 65 and older and individuals with a compromised immune system



## **Standard Flu Vaccine (trivalent):**

- Protects against 2 influenza A and 1 influenza B
- Approved for ages 6 months and older
