NEW Quadrivalent Flu Vaccine:

- Protects against 2 influenza A and 2 influenza B
- Approved for ages 4 years and older



Intradermal Quadrivalent Flu Vaccine:

- Protects against 2 influenza A and 2 influenza B
- Approved for ages 18 through 64 years of age



High-dose Flu Vaccine (trivalent):

- Protects against 2 influenza A and 1 influenza B
- Recommended for ages 65 and older and individuals with a compromised immune system



Standard Flu Vaccine (trivalent):

- Protects against 2 influenza A and 1 influenza B
- Approved for ages 6 months and older





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
