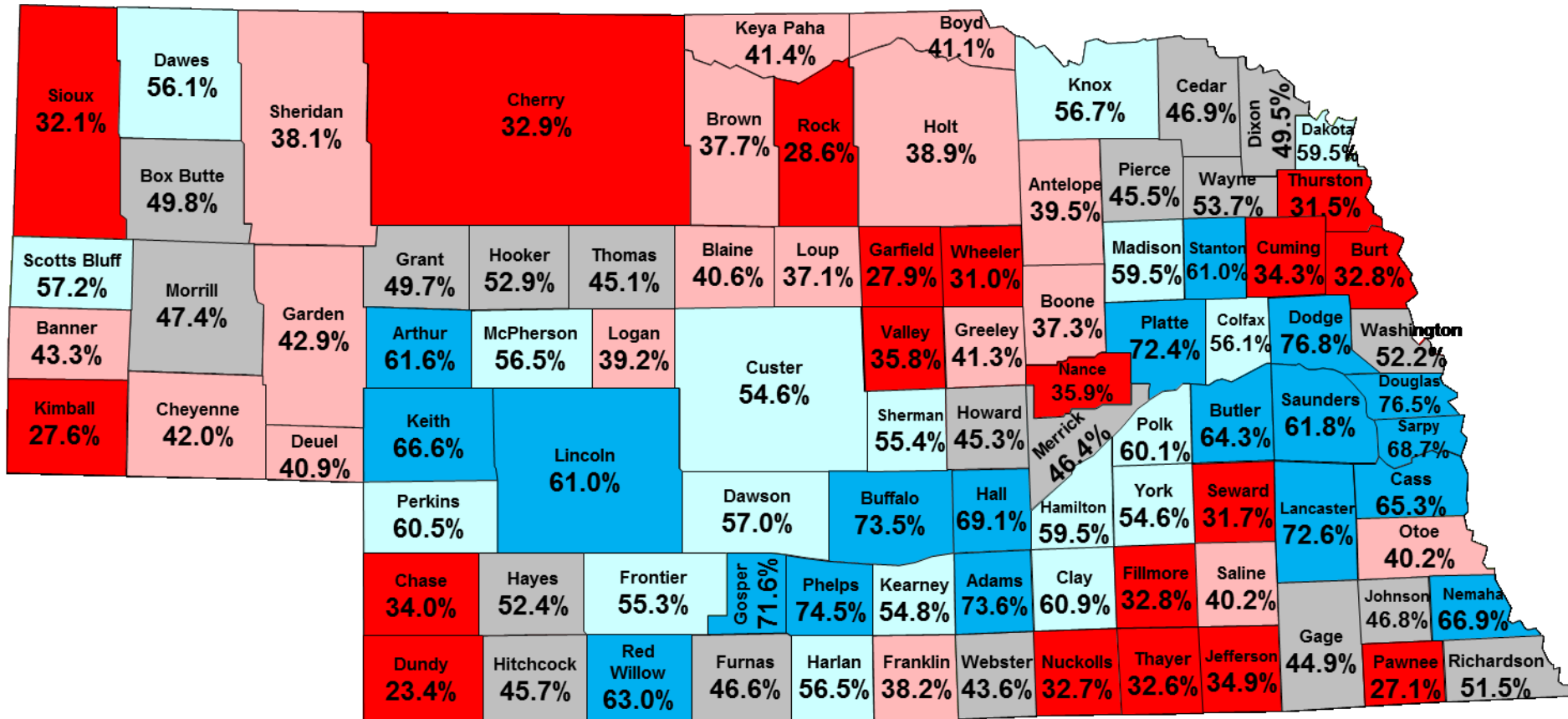


Nebraska Pneumococcal Pneumonia Vaccination Rates
