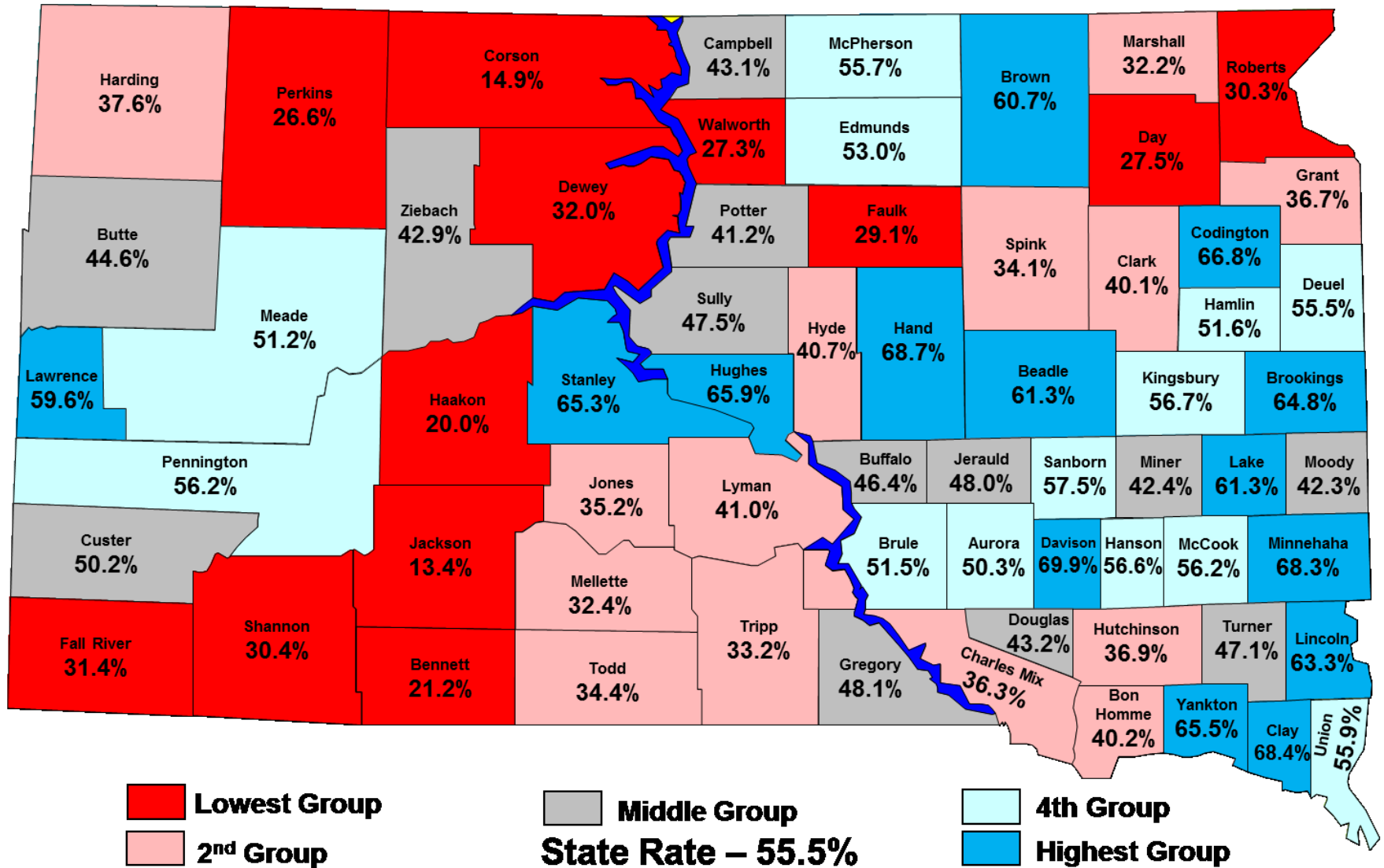


South Dakota Influenza Vaccination Rates
