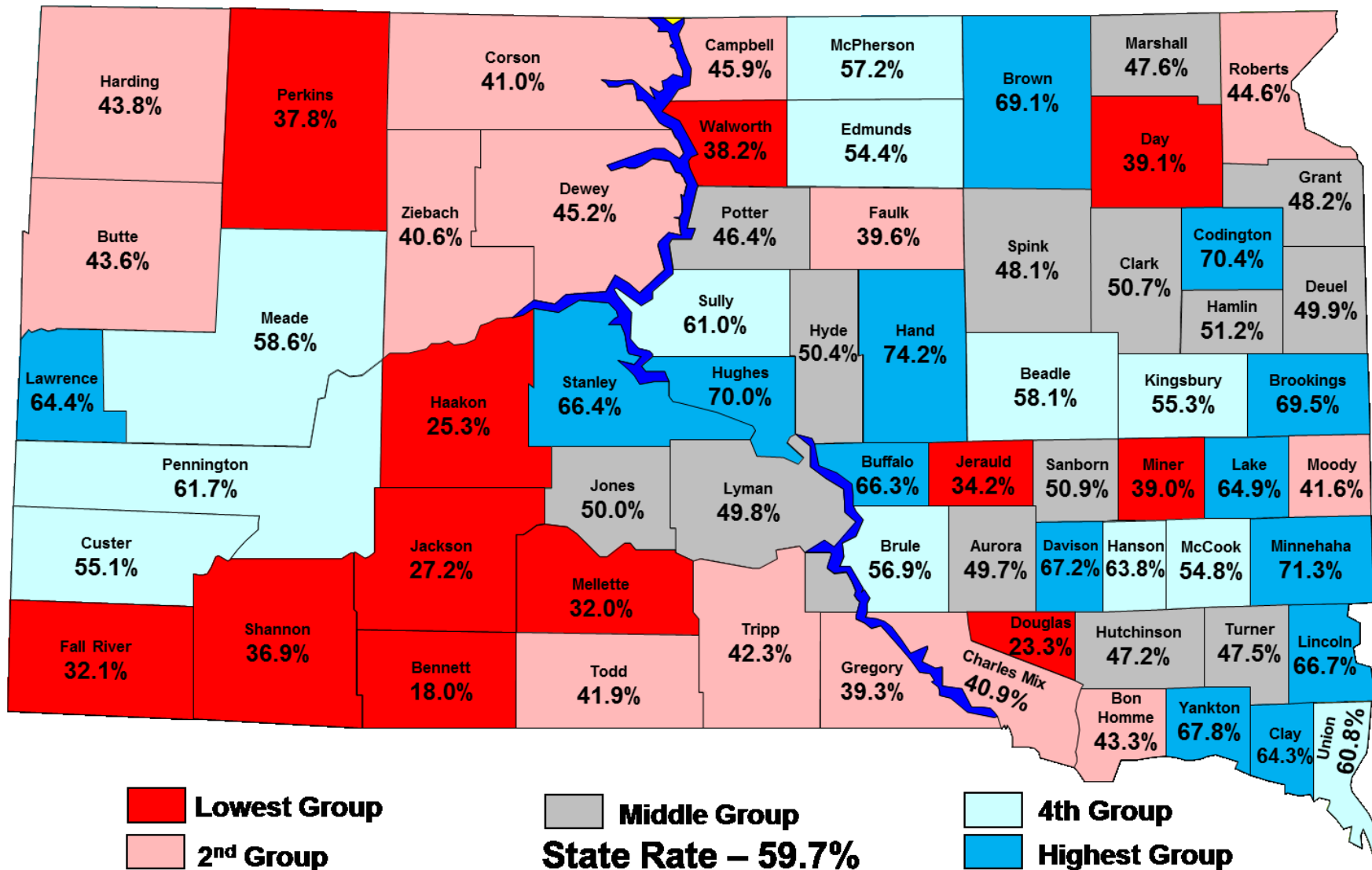


South Dakota Pneumococcal Pneumonia Vaccination Rates
