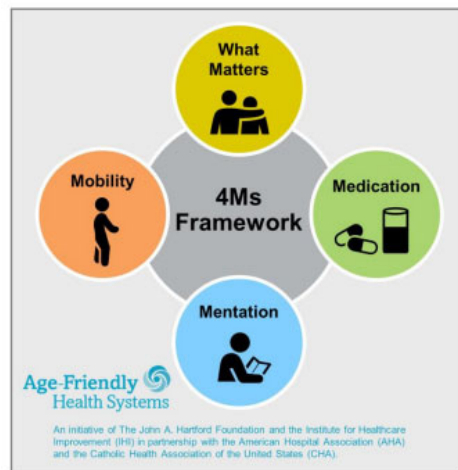

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### What Matters

Know and align care with each older adult's specific health outcome goals and care preferences including, but not limited to, end-of-life care, and across settings of care.

### Medication

If medication is necessary, use Age-Friendly medication that does not interfere with What Matters to the older adult, Mobility, or Mentation across settings of care.

### Mentation

Prevent, identify, treat, and manage dementia, depression, and delirium across settings of care.

### Mobility

Ensure that older adults move safely every day in order to maintain function and do What Matters.

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## Pathway to Safer Opioid Use



### ▪ Naloxone

- A life-saving medication that can reverse an overdose from opioids when given in time
- Should be administered to anyone who presents with signs of opioid overdose or if opioid overdose is suspected
- If mistakenly given Naloxone to someone who is not overdosing on opioids, you will not help or harm them
- Both ND and SD have Good Samaritan Laws that protect anyone who administers Naloxone to reverse an opioid overdose and contact 911

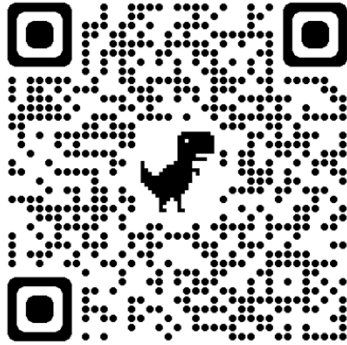
