The infection preventionist (IP), under the direction of the director of nursing services, is responsible for the development, implementation, direction and operation of the facility's infection prevention and control program. The IP's responsibilities include ensuring compliance with infection-related regulations from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and operationalizing guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
